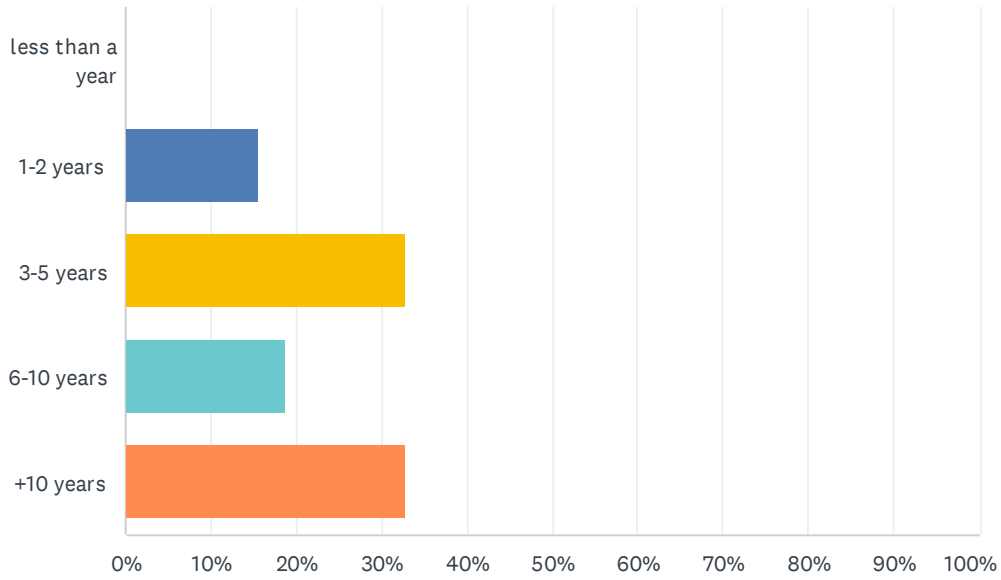


Q1 How long have you been mountain biking?

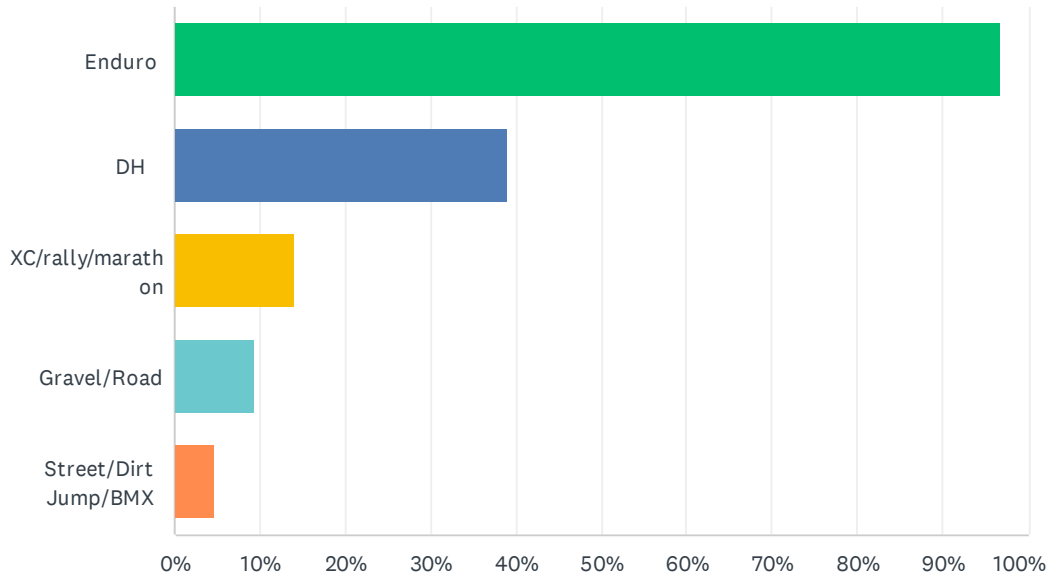

Q2 Which disciplines you do the most?

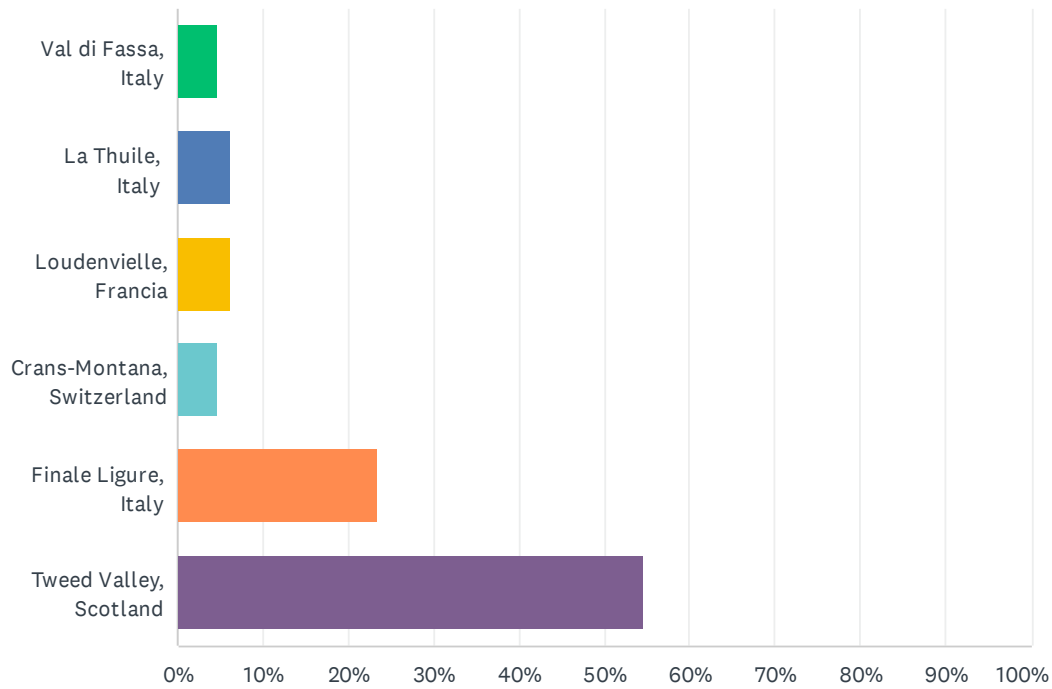

Q3 Which race you liked the most in 2021?

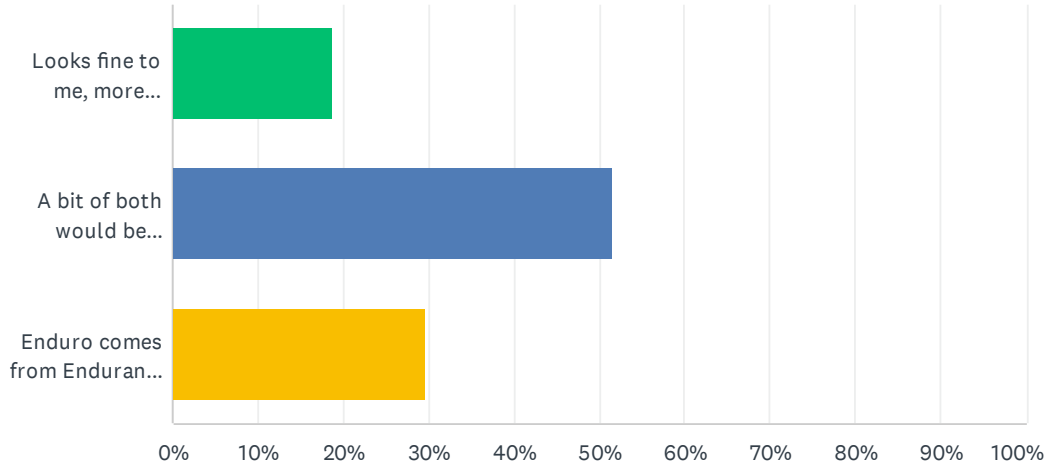

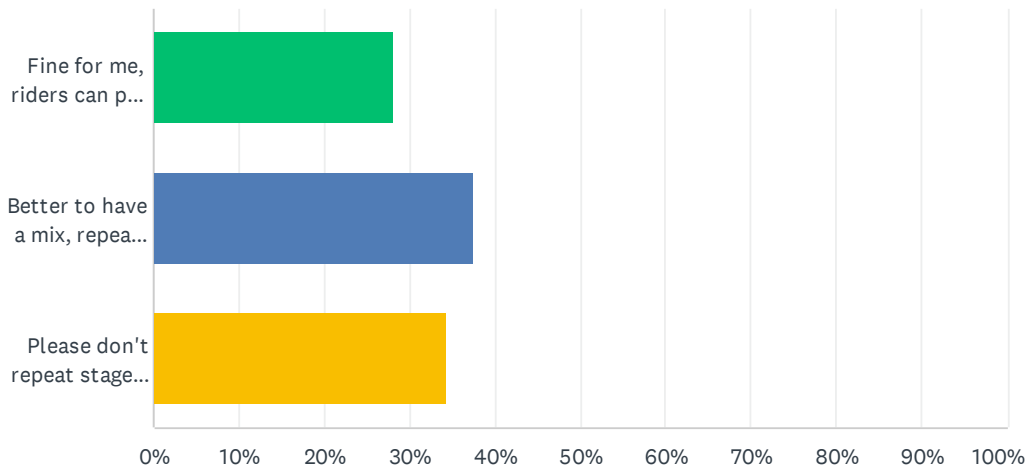

Q5 This year the double header races repeated the same stages each day.

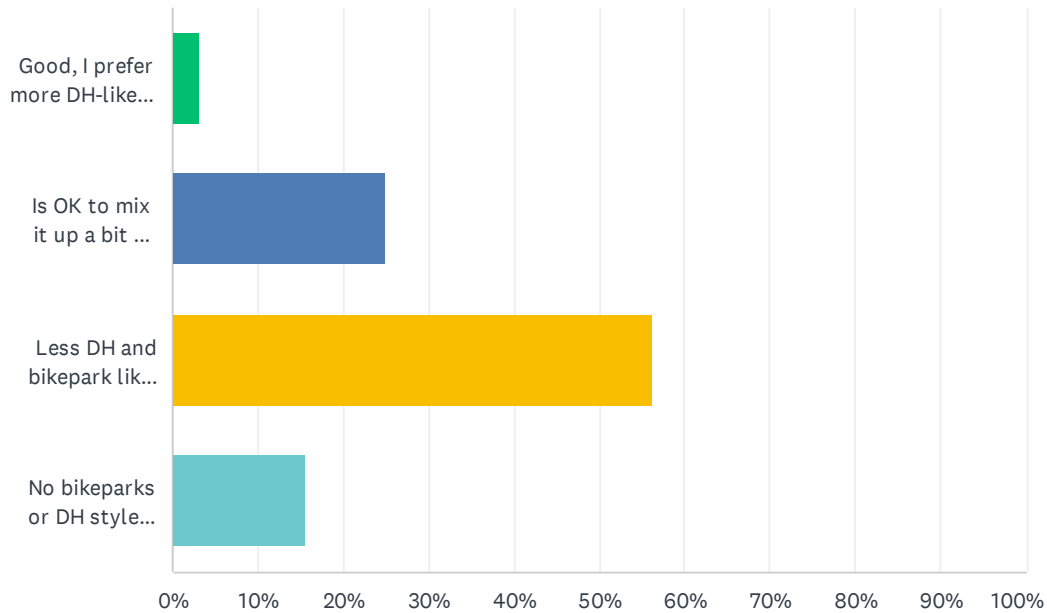

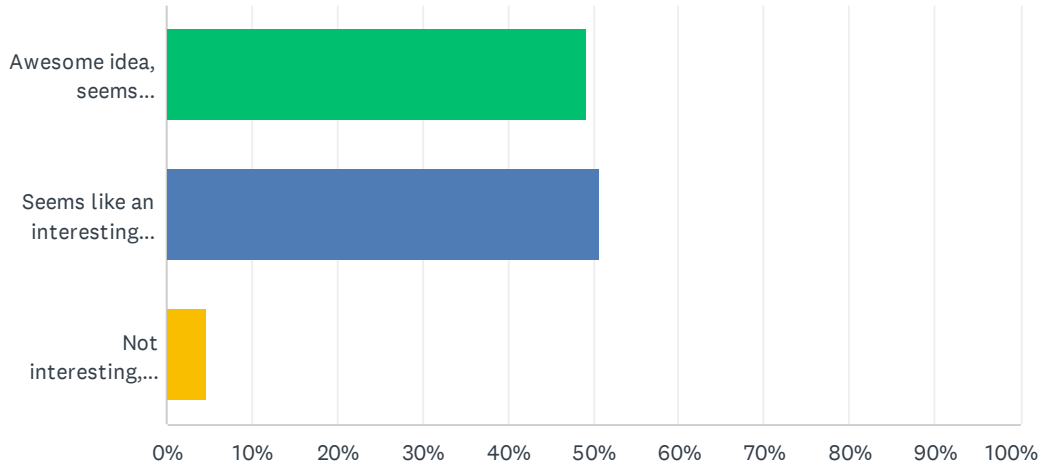
